


Volunteering is local – some evidence

We analysed our online applications via www.do-it.org for 1st January 2015 to 23 December 2015 looking at the location of volunteers and the Opportunities they applied for. We ignored applications without a GL postcode and Opportunities that were not at a fixed point. The 635 Applications are plotted against "crow-flies" mileage below. The mileages are truncated to the nearest whole number so for example the "0" column relates to distances from 0 up to 0.99999 miles.



Just over 30% applied for Opportunities within a mile of their home and 56% restricted themselves to a 2 mile radius. Over 75% of Applications were for Opportunities less than 4 miles from home. Only around 6% looked over 10miles
